The coordinator will consult with appropriate organizations to determine the needs and develop programs and activities in response to those needs with an emphasis on Gwich'in culture, self-reliance, and land based activities. This position is also responsible for assisting in coordinating and supervision of youth groups to attend other Yukon Flats activities and/or events in collaboration with the other Behavioral Health staff. This is a part-time position.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalency (GED)
- Experience working with youth is an asset
- Experience planning and facilitating camps and/or events is an asset
- Supervisory and/or management skills is an asset

Main Duties Include:

- Development, planning, and organization of the Gwich'in Heritage Cultural Program
- Budget, record and track expenditures
- Facilitating all aspects of the Gwich'in Heritage Cultural Program
- Promote the camp and ensure that information is readily available to Yukon Flats citizens
- Daily interaction and supervision of activity participants and other support staff
- Adhere to and enforce CATG health and safety and personnel policies
