The addiction recovery technicians are responsible for supervision of consumers to ensure their safety and well-being. At the Addie Shewfelt building, open doors program. Coverage is usually needed during evening, weekend, and overnight shift hours. Currently seeking (2) applicants in providing as needed/part-time coverage. The applicant will be working outdoors taking clients out, boating, hunting, fishing, wood gathering and other outdoor cultural/subsistence activities as needed.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. Provide group education.
- 2. Transport consumers as necessary.
- 3. Assist with orientation of new consumers.
- 4. Complete paper and electronic documentation within required time frames.
- 5. Attend staff meetings.
- 6. Conduct disaster drill on each shift.
- 7. Observe policies and maintain high standards of professional behavior.

QUALIFICATIONS: High school diploma or GED required. At least eighteen (18) years of age, and obtain a valid driver's license at the time of hire.

Good verbal and written communication skills and ability to attend a 2-day orientation (Monday-Tuesday) required.
