POSITION SUMMARY:

The addiction recovery technicians are responsible for supervision of consumers to ensure their safety and well-being. At the Addie Shewfelt building, open doors program. Coverage is usually needed during evening, weekend, and overnight shift hours. The applicant will be working outdoors taking clients out, boating, hunting, fishing, wood gathering and other outdoor cultural/subsistence activities as needed.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Provide group education.
2. Transport consumers as necessary.
3. Assist with orientation of new consumers.
4. Complete paper and electronic documentation within required time frames.
5. Attend staff meetings.
6. Conduct disaster drill on each shift.
7. Observe policies and maintain high standards of professional behavior.

QUALIFICATIONS: High school diploma or GED required. At least eighteen (18) years of age, and obtain a valid driver's license at the time of hire.

Good verbal and written communication skills and ability to attend a 2-day orientation (Monday-Tuesday) required.

Must be certified or must complete BLS (Basic Life Support) Training, CPR First Aide.

Must be comfortable working closely with people with addictions disorders and have a desire to provide excellent client care. On-site training provided.
